The interiors of the St. Tropez 211 are equally well-crafted, with leather-covered seats in turguoise and white tones, offering both comfort and pleasing aesthetics. The seating is arranged to promote socializing on board, allowing passengers to enjoy the sun and the scenery in full relaxation.

A true gem of nautical craftsmanship, the St. Tropez 211 is a boat "LIKE NEW." It is powered by a robust 350-horsepower engine, and the three onboard batteries ensure that all electronic and navigation systems can function seamlessly throughout the day at sea. The St. Tropez 211 is equipped with two 260-liter fuel tanks and a manual anchor. The St. Tropez 211 boat has undergone a complete restoration, with an antiosmosis treatment applied to ensure its long-term durability. The waterline has been finished with an elegant Riva turquoise color, echoing the classic style of these vessels. The propeller shaft has been fully disassembled and overhauled, with the seals replaced to ensure optimal performance. The electrical system has been completely renewed, as has the engine compartment, now fully renovated.

The boat's interior has also been refurbished, with the cabin beneath the deck fully redone and fitted with new amenities. The exterior cushions, including the sunbathing area and the rear bench, have been renewed to provide maximum comfort and a refined look. The helm and windshield have been updated, with the glass replaced by plexiglass for greater strength and visibility. The lighting system is entirely new, ensuring safety and functionality. Additionally, new toilets have been installed, and the water system has been replaced. To complete the restoration, the boat comes with a Riva cover, protecting the entire vessel when not in use.
