DESCRIPTION

GRAND BANKS 59 ALEUTIAN RP (2007) GRAND BANKS 59 ALEUTIAN RP is a 17.85M (58'7") performance trawler, built in 2007 by the American Grand Banks shipyard. In good overall condition, she has been carefully maintained by her successive owners. Her modified deep-V hull, designed in collaboration with naval architects Sparkman & Stephens, combines remarkable performance with offshore cruising comfort. Powered by twin Caterpillar C18 ACERT engines of 1,000 hp each (2,000 hp total), she shows only 1,225 running hours. This configuration allows her to cruise comfortably at 20 knots and reach an impressive top speed of 25+ knots, while maintaining the stability and quietness that Grand Banks is renowned for. Her interior layout accommodates up to 6 guests in 3 staterooms, all with ensuite bathrooms. The full-beam master suite features custom joinery and exceptional comfort, complemented by a VIP stateroom and a guest cabin with twin berths. The two-level salon with raised pilothouse creates a bright and welcoming living space.

This Grand Banks 59 Aleutian RP stands out with her large panoramic windows that flood the interior with natural light. Her generous aft cockpit offers multiple spaces for relaxation and entertaining, while the spacious flybridge provides a second helm station, extensive sunbathing area and shaded dining zone under the bimini.
